The design was created by closely observing the structure of the fabric. Taking into account that this new fabric would be utilised as screens for pavilions, Doshi Levien created a fabric that would permit the passage of light and emit a pleasant chequered shadow pattern. The same fabric can also be used in cushions for Kettal furniture.


